Srinagar, the 12 July, 2019

SROUUT-In exercise of the powers conferred by section 96 of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 (Central Act No. 59 of 1988), the Government of Jammu and Kashmir hereby intends to make the following amendment in the Jammu and Kashmir Motor Vehicles Rules, 1991; namely:-

Rule 88 shall be substituted by the following:-

- "88. Carriages of animals in goods vehicles (1) No Bovine animal shall be carried in a goods vehicle in public unless:-
- i. minimum space allowance to bovine weighing upto 200 Kg, 200-300 Kg, 300-400 Kg and above 400 Kg is given minimum space of 1 Square Meter, 1.20 Square Meter, 1.40 Square Meter and 2.0 Square Meter respectively.
- ii. The Space requirement for Bovine while being transported in commonly sized road vehicles shall be as under:-

(2) No Equine animal shall be carried in a goods vehicle in public unless:-

A minimum space allowance to; Stallion Horse, mares (including pregnant mares), mares with foal and ponies are given minimum space of 2.25, 2.0, 2.25 and 1.5 square meters respectively.

(3) No animal belonging to or intended for a circus, menagerie or zoo

shall be carried in a goods vehicle in a public place unless;

In case of a wild or ferocious animal, a suitable cage, either separate from or integral with the load body of the vehicle used of sufficient strength to contain the animal securely at times is provided, and

Reasonable space for each animal is provided in the vehicle. ii.

(4) Apart from conditions mentioned under sub-rule (1)(2) and (3), the following conditions shall be complied with while carrying any animal in a goods vehicle:-

- a. A valid certificate by a qualified veterinarian to the effect that the animals are in a fit condition to travel by rail or road and are not suffering from any infectious or contagious or parasitic diseases and that they have been vaccinated against infectious or contagious or parasitic diseases, shall accompany each consignment. In the absence of such a certificate, the carrier shall refuse to accept the consignment for transport;
- b. Veterinary first-aid equipment shall accompany all batches of animals;
- c. Each consignment shall bear a label showing in bold red letters the name, address and telephone number (if any) of the consignor and consignee, the number and types of animals being transported and quantity of rations and food provided;

d. Suitable rope and platforms should be used for loading animals

- e. Animal shall be loaded after they are properly fed and given
- f. Animals in advanced stage of pregnancy shall not be mixed with
- young animals in order to avoid stampede during transportation; g. Watering arrangements on route shall be made and sufficient quantities of water shall be carried for emergency;



h. Sufficient feed and fodder with adequate reserve shall be carried to last during the journey;

i. Male animals and other male young stock shall not be mixed

with female stock in the same compartment;

j. Material for padding, such as straw, shall be placed on the floor to avoid injury if an animal lies down, and the padding shall not be less than 5 cm. thick;

k. Adequate ventilation shall be ensured;

l. In case of transportation of Sheep and Goat in Two tier Truck the floor of upper tier shall be well insulated with 5 inch bedding material and

m. No vehicle carrying any animal shall be driven in excess of 40 kilometers per hour.

Explanation; - For the purpose of this rule "bovine" includes, buffalo, cattle, yak, or the young ones thereof and "equine" includes Horse, Mare, Pony, Mule, Ass, Donkey and their young

Any person who desires to object to the afore-said proposal/amendment may submit his/her objections in writing to Administrative Secretary to Government, Transport the Department, Civil Secretariat within a period of six weeks from the date of publication of this notification. Any objection/suggestion received after the expiry of the said period shall not be entertained.
